New Intermediate Competitive Program Beginning Fall 2017

RCE Membership,

Real Colorado Edge Soccer Club is excited to announce our Fall 2017 – Spring 2018 programs for players 11U-19U, boys and girls. We continue to create quality programs in order to benefit all levels of players, as well as, accommodate for an increasing number of players in the Northwest Denver area.



In addition to our current Competitive and Recreational programs for Ages 11U-19U, we have created an Intermediate Competitive program to service the needs of our club members. Some key changes: The Intermediate program will be considered competitive soccer and encompasses our Mustangs and Wildcats teams, as well as additional teams as our club continues to grow. The Intermediate program will have access to the club curriculum, staff coaches support and input, as well as trained and certified coaches. Players in the Intermediate program will not have regularly scheduled staff training during the season, rather players will be able to individually add staff training to their seasonal schedule for an extra fee. The staff training will be coached to each player with a focus on individual technical growth and development. Intermediate teams will practice two days per week from early August to early November, and mid-February to the end of May along with program fees that will be tiered appropriately. Lastly, players wanting to play either Competitive or Intermediate Competitive, will still go through the yearly player placement / tryout process and placed on a team that best fits their ability level.

The Intermediate program is also available for current recreational teams who desire to improve their skills and face additional challenges, yet aren't quite ready to join a competitive team. Recreational teams can play together in this Intermediate program and compete against more challenging opponents. Current Recreational coaches, please contact your appropriate age group Director of Coaching to discuss further if interested in this option.
